Description of District Awards

Spark Plug Award

The purpose of the MOECOMDWS District *Spark Plug Award* is to honor that registered adult working at the unit level that put an extra spark in the Unit's program in the past year. One award is given at each program level, Cub Scouting, Boy Scouting and Venturing.

Partners in Scouting Award

The purpose of the MOECOMDWS District *Partners in Scouting Award* is to honor a married couple for their involvement in the Scouting program.

Helping Hand Award

The purpose of the MOECOMDWS District *Helping Hand Award* is to honor a Commissioner who has gone above and beyond the prescribed duties to aid leaders in strengthening their Units. This results in a stronger program for the boys and therefore a stronger MOECOMDWS District.

George C. Eisenman Award
